First Aid - The Commission should review the First Aid equivalencies in the requirements of various organizations.

Training for Etienne - Various options were discussed (see below).

4. Holly is continuing to discuss transportation issues with Acwsalcta. There are a few options available so maybe we can have reliable transportation to the pool this summer.
