## Minutes

1. Pool - The pump is cutting off frequently. There are health and safety issues if the pool is not being fully circulated. Chris is working on the problem and phoning various resources. Otherwise things are going well: the schools are happy and the opening sessions went well.
2. Family Passes - Each family pass will have on it a list of people who are authorized to use it.
3. Family Lessons - There will be no subsidies. Staff can inform the public of other sources of financial aid: Patrons are encouraged to keep their receipt and use it for income tax returns. The Nuxalk Nation Council and Social Assistance may provide bursaries. The Credit Union may offer loans or bursaries, upon request.
4. Printer/fax machine for Pool Office - Wendy is looking into this.
5. AWSI/WSI and Splashback Courses - Participants will pay Coleen Fraser directly for teaching and materials. The CCRD and Pool Commission will not be involved. If necessary, students can contact the above institutions for funds.
