4. 2014 Manager's Report - Janice will assist with this if necessary.

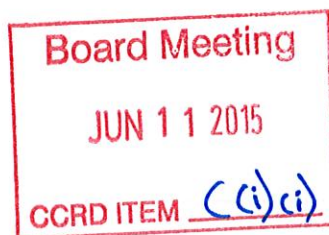
