To the CCRD Directors.

This is to confirm my advance-notice emailed request that, as a matter of priority, the CCRD Board, at its September 11, 2014 Meeting, seriously consider directing its Administrative Staff to make necessary arrangements to have emergency response training provided to one or two local residents in Bella Coola Townsite, Lower Bella Coola Valley (including the Reserve), Hagensborg, Nusatsum & Glacier View, Firvale & Upper Firvale, Stuie, and such other CCRD ares as you may decide.

I believe the most appropriate training should specifically include preparedness for the following events:
Flood/Fire/Earthquake/Landslide/Vehicle Accident/and such other you decide (including Tsunami for selected area residents).

Such emergency response training should only be offered to those full-time residents who have no objections to their names being published by the CCRD and EMBC.
