SUBJECT: **Area A – Director’s Report**

Roads

Ministry visited Denny Island on May 21st and surveyed the road prior to grading and met with Director McCullagh. Leanna Ilnicki surveyed the damaged culvert that broke away in Whiskey Slough in the winter of 2014 and measurements were taken to start the replacement. Another culvert was also earmarked for replacement as the bottom has rotted out.

We discussed the road brushing which no one remembers being done since 2013. It is becoming critical that brushing is done very soon as visibility in some areas is substantially reduced. I touch base with Pat Gunderson regarding the brushing; he states that it was done last year (I think it was 2013) and did not have it on his work plan to do this year. At the time of this discussion he had completed the grading and was preparing to leave Denny Island that day. I will be taking pictures and passing them along to Interior Roads and the Ministry.

Tsunami Alarm

I have been approached by a member of the community regarding the installation of an emergency siren. There is currently one installed by Shearwater Marine but is not heard beyond the immediate retail area. What are the steps needed to start this project? How extensive and what is the cost? What is CCRD’s responsibility in this emergency exercise?

Early Summer Weather

As with most of the province there are concerns about water on Denny Island. The lack of rain has had an impact on residential water stores and there is concern about the rest of the summer. Shearwater provides potable water to their areas, and allows DI residents to fill containers. Increased usage will make for an interesting summer.

Denny Island Rec

Denny Island’s annual 10K run and Gumboot Dayz are tentatively slated for 1st July 2015.
