This is a letter of request for help in the repair of the break though of Burnt Bridge Creek, which is flooding lands and basements and eroding the main highway, also a threat to 8 or more power poles.

I have lived at this location since 1969 and have never had my basement flood until now. For the last month, I have had 6-8 inches of water in my basement, efforts to remove the water helped, but the water returned to the same level again. I know in the 80's they built a dike at Burnt Bridge which has held, but since the September 2010 flood with all the gravel that washed down there has been a need to extend the riprap another 300m to protect our community and infrastructure.

Right now my driveway is virtually impassible. Only a truck (borrowed) is able to get through. The drive way for Rainbow West Helicopters & Hodson Guiding is completely washed out.

The wash out of our driveways is a continuing problem, as is the highway erosion, with any small water level change.
